

History and Vision

Welcome to this public exhibition. Here, you can find out more about BT and Aviva Investors' proposals for the re-use of the Radio Station site and a new Sustainable Urban Extension (SUE) for Rugby.

In April 2011, BT and Aviva Investors – working as Rugby Radio Station Limited Partnership (RRSLP) – submitted an Outline Planning Application to Rugby Borough Council for the redevelopment and regeneration of land west of the A5.

A separate application for development consent for land east of the A5 is being made to the Infrastructure Planning Commission (IPC) for commercial/employment development and an expansion of the highly-successful DIRFT facility ('DIRFT III'). That is the subject of a different consultation.

Now, Rugby Borough Council – as the local authority responsible for processing and determining the Outline Planning Application for the SUE – is asking people for their comments and feedback on the SUE Application.
