APPLICATION FOR A SUSTAINABLE URBAN EXTENSION FOR RUGBY

BT and Aviva Investors – working as Rugby Radio Station Limited Partnership (RRSLP) – have submitted an Outline Planning Application to Rugby Borough Council for the redevelopment of the Radio Station site on land within Rugby Borough.

The Application was shaped by the 2009 Design Enquiry and has been developed drawing on a wide range of technical, stakeholder and community contributions.

This Application is now the subject of statutory consultation by Rugby Borough Council.

Members of the community are invited to comment on the Outline Planning Application. These comments will be considered by Rugby Borough Council as part of its assessment of the Application.

To help people find out more about the proposals and the Application, RRSLP will be hosting a series of drop in public exhibitions.
